APPLIANCES AND FURNITURE

LARGE AND SMALL SCRAP METAL

BUNDLED BRUSH / YARD WASTE

- Branches must be smaller than three inches in diameter and five feet in length and tied with twine. Place in bundles that can be carried by one person, otherwise, the materials can not be accepted.
- Brush piles must be no more than what can fit in one level standard-size pickup truck.

GENERAL JUNK

- Boxed or bundled with twine under 100 pounds per item.
- Canned paint must be brought into a solid state with removable lid and bagged.

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED

The following materials will NOT be accepted:

CONSTRUCTION ITEMS

- No construction materials from businesses or contractors.
- No railroad ties, concrete, bricks, shingles.
- No asbestos.

ELECTRONICS

- No TVs, computers, printers, stereos, cell phones, etc.

EXCEPTIONALLY HEAVY AND BULKY ITEMS

- No heavy or bulky items such as pianos or organs.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

- No motor oil, solvents, propane tanks or household chemicals.
- No fluorescent tubes and bulbs.

PLUMBING FIXTURES

- No tubs, sinks, toilets, or other fixtures.

BATTERIES

ORGANIC MATERIALS

- No household trash such as food waste.
